RESOLUTION NO. 924.95 OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF
THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; SUPPORTING
MIAMI BEACH'S INVESTIGATION OF THE
UTILIZATION OF ARAGONITE SAND FOR BEACH
RENOURISHMENT ALONG MIAMI BEACH; PROVIDING
FOR DISTRIBUTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Golden Beach is concerned about the negative environmental impact of the recent beach renourishment activities, to the extent that it had filed for and received a preliminary injunction in the U.S. District Court, Southern District of Florida; and

WHEREAS, it has been represented to the town that alternative borrow sites are being considered in the Bahamas as a source for Aragonite sand.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the Town Council supports the inquiry by the City of Miami Beach in the use of Bahamian Aragonite sand as a possible alternative source of sand for renourishment of the beach along Miami Beach. This inquiry should determine the environmental impact, if any, of the Aragonite sand. Golden Beach would consider supporting an alternative solution to beach renourishment that did not disturb the reefs off shore from Golden Beach and did not have any other negative environmental impact.

Section 2. That the Town Clerk is authorized and directed to send a copy of this resolution to the City of Miami Beach.

Section 3. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective upon approval of the Town Council.
