RESOLUTION NO. 925.95 OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF
THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; ADOPTING
THE AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE POLICE
OFFICERS BARGAINING UNIT OF THE TOWN OF
GOLDEN BEACH; PROVIDING FOR A WAGE
ADJUSTMENT; PROVIDING FOR FUNDING; PROVIDING
FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS;
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the representatives of the Town and the Dade County Police Benevolent Association, Inc. (on behalf of the police bargaining unit) have negotiated a proposed labor agreement; and

WHEREAS, the proposed agreement on January 12, 1995 was ratified by the police bargaining unit, passing by a majority vote; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council, after consideration of the issues, desires to adopt the agreement;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the labor agreement between the Town of Golden Beach and the Dade County Police Benevolent Association on behalf of the police bargaining unit is hereby ratified; said agreement being effective immediately with some specified provisions effective retroactively to October 1, 1994. The agreement expires September 30, 1996.

Section 2. The appropriate town officials are authorized and directed to execute the agreement.

Section 3. Funding for this agreement shall be appropriate form the police department budget.

Section 4. Severability. Should any provisions of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.

Section 5. Conflict. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances, all Town Code sections or parts of Town Code sections, and all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
