**RESOLUTION NO. 984.96**

RESOLUTION NO. 984.96 OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; URGING THE METROPOLITAN DADE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO COMPLETE THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PROGRAM FOR DADE COUNTY, TO DESIGNATE THE HURRICANE EVACUATION SHELTER FOR THE RESIDENTS OF GOLDEN BEACH AND TO INSPECT THE DESIGNATED SHELTER FOR CODE COMPLIANCE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Hurricane Season in South Florida is beginning; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Golden Beach is in the Coastal Evacuation Area since the entire town is located between the Intracoastal Waterway and the Atlantic Ocean; and

WHEREAS, a determination of the public facility that will be designated as the emergency shelter for the Town needs to be made;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

**Section 1.** That the Metropolitan Dade County Board of County Commissioners is urged to take the following action:

- A. Complete the Hurricane Emergency Preparedness Plan.
- B. Designate the public facility that will serve the residents of the Town of Golden Beach if the need should arise during a hurricane warning.
- C. Provide for a code compliance inspection of said facility based upon the provisions of the 1994 South Florida Building Code - Dade County Edition, and the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) Standards for Minimum Loads for Buildings (for wind), particularly if the facility is a public school building, since such structures are built pursuant to separate state regulations and not the South Florida Building Code.
- D. Make any safety improvements that are needed as determined by the inspection of the facility.

**RESOLUTION NO. 984.96**

Section 2. That the Town Clerk is authorized and directed to send copies of this resolution to the members of the Metropolitan Dade County Board of County Commissioners and to the County Administrator.

Section 3. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective upon approval of the Town Council.
