RESOLUTION NO. 990.96

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN
OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; APPOINTING SARI
ADDICOTT AS LIAISON BETWEEN THE TOWN OF
GOLDEN BEACH AND THE DADE COUNTY SCHOOL
BOARD; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH,
FLORIDA:

Section 1.

That the position of Liaison for Relations between the Dade County School Board and the Town of Golden Beach is hereby created.

Section 2. That the duties of the position are to create and maintain lines of communication between the town and the Dade County School Board, for the exchange of factual information, the participation in comprehensive planning process and the pursuit of other directives provided by action of the Town Council for the town's benefit. Activities of the liaison shall be pursuant to the vote of the Town Council with day-to-day coordination with the Town Manager. The liaison shall gather and disseminate information affecting the town. She shall not have the authority to bind the town in any contractual relationships or to conduct press conferences, issue press releases or other mass mailings.

Section 3. The liaison shall not be entitled to any salary or employment benefits, but shall receive reimbursement for necessary actual budgeted expenses related to the performance of her duties as approved by the Town Manager.

Section 4. The term of office shall expire on July 1, 1997 and may be renewed for successive one year terms thereafter expiring on July 1. The liaison shall serve at the pleasure of the Town Council.

Section 5. The first appointment of the Dade County School Board liaison is hereby made to Sari Addicott.

Section 6. Severability. Should any provisions of this Resolution be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the Resolution as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.


Section 7. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 8. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective upon approval of the Town Council.


