A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; ACCEPTING A PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE FOR THE 1966/97 FISCAL YEAR; ALSO COMPUTING A ROLL-BACK MILLAGE RATE; PROVIDING FOR THE DATE, TIME AND PLACE AT WHICH A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE AND A TENTATIVE BUDGET; DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE TOWN OFFICIALS TO ADVISE THE DADE COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER'S OFFICE OF THE INFORMATION CONTAINED HEREIN; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the Town has computed a proposed millage rate base for the 1996/97 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Town has also computed a roll-back millage rate based on the taxable value within the Town that has been certified by the Dade County Property Appraiser's Office; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to advise the Property Appraiser's Office of the date, time and place of the first public hearing at which the proposed millage rate and a tentative budget will be considered; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to establish the date, time and place of a second public hearing for the adoption of the final millage rate and budget; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Town Council hereby accepts a proposed millage rate in the amount of 8.7377 mills, which is equivalent to \$8.7377 per \$1,000 of taxable assessed property valuation, for the 1996/97 fiscal year.

Section 2. The roll-back millage rate has been computed to be 8.5285 mills, based on the certification of taxable value provided by the Property Appraiser's Office.

Section 3. A public hearing is hereby scheduled to be held Tuesday, September 3, 1996 at 7:30 p.m. in Town Hall (One Golden Beach Drive, Golden Beach, Florida).

Section 4. The appropriate Town officials are hereby authorized and directed to advise the Dade County Property Appraiser's Office of the information contained in this resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective upon approval of the Town Council.


