RESOLUTION NO. 995.96 OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; APPROVING COLA AND MERIT INCREASES AND FUNDING FOR EMPLOYEE BENEFITS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, as part of the budget review and adoption process for the 1996/97 fiscal year, the Town Council desires to provide for certain salary, wage and benefits for designated employees;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That effective October 1, 1996, a 3% cost of living adjustment (COLA) is hereby approved to increase the salary or wages for all employees outside bargaining unit

Section 2. That effective October 1, 1996, funding in the amount of \$10,000.00 for a merit increase program is hereby implemented for the 1996/97 fiscal year.

Section 3. That effective October 1, 1996, a \$600.00 monthly car allowance will be funded to cover leasing, insurance, maintenance and fuel costs for a motor vehicle for the Town Manager. Any such lease shall be subject to the Town Council's approval. Until such approval, the Town Manager may be reimbursed for her auto expenses in an amount not to exceed the monthly limit indicated herein.

Section 4. Severability. Should any provisions of this Resolution be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the Resolution as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.

Section 5. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective upon approval of the Town Council.
