RESOLUTION NO. 997.96

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 1996 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 1997 PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTE SECTION 200.065 (TRIM BILL); SETTING DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR PUBLIC HEARING TO ADOPT FINAL BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH; AUTHORIZING TOWN CLERK TO ADVERTISE PUBLIC HEARING; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town has properly noticed the first public hearing scheduled for September 3, 1996 at 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall located at One Golden Beach Drive, Golden Beach, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the said first public hearing was held as noticed and the public and all interested parties having had an opportunity to address their comments to the Town Council and having complied with the "TRIM" requirements of the Florida Statutes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the tentative millage as presented by the Mayor and Town Manager for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 1996 and ending September 30, 1997 be and is hereby fixed at the rate of 8.7377 mills which is \$8.7377 dollars per one thousand dollars of assessed property value within the Town of Golden Beach.

Section 2. That the "rolled back rate" for the Town of Golden Beach is 8.5285 per thousand dollars and that the tentative millage rate of 8.7377 is 2.45% above the "rolled back rate".

Section 3. That the second public hearing required by Section 200.065 of the Florida Statutes to adopt a final millage rate for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 1996 and ending September 30, 1997 be and is hereby set in the Town Council Chamber, One Golden Beach Drive, Golden Beach, Florida at 6:30 p.m. on September 17, 1996.



Section 4. That the Town Clerk be and is hereby authorized and directed to advertise the said public hearing as required by law.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective upon approval of the Town Council.

The Motion to adopt the foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilmember Rosenthal seconded by Councilmember Lowrance and on roll call the following vote ensued:
