A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2016 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2017 PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTE 200.065 (TRIM BILL); SETTING A DATE FOR A FINAL PUBLIC HEARING TO ADOPT THE MILLAGE RATE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on August 4th, 2016, the Town transmitted to the Property Appraiser its "Proposed Millage Rate" for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2016 and further scheduled the public hearing required by Section 200.065 of the Florida Statutes to be held on September 6, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Property Appraiser has properly noticed the public hearing scheduled for September 6, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at One Golden Beach Drive, Golden Beach, Florida, as required by Chapter 200 of the Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing, as required by Section 200.065(2)(c), was held by the Town Council on September 6, 2016, commencing at 7:00 p.m., as previously noticed and the public and all interested parties having had the opportunity to address their comments to the Town Council and the Town Council having considered the comments of the public regarding the proposed millage rate and having complied with the "TRIM" requirements of the Florida Statutes.
