<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Agreement Approved.</u> That the Agreement, in substantially the form attached hereto, between the Town and Tennis Pro is hereby approved, and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement, on behalf of the Town, once approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the Town Attorney.

Section 3. Implementation. That the Mayor and Town Manager are hereby authorized to take any and all action necessary to implement this Resolution and the Agreement in accordance with the terms, conditions and purposes of this Resolution and the Agreement.

Section 4. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
