## **RESOLUTION NO. <u>1879.07</u>**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A MOBILE POLICE RADIO FOR A TAKE HOME POLICE VEHICLE; AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT FOR A PORTION OF THE COST TO PURCHASE SAID RADIO; AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF LAW ENFORCMENT TRUST FUND MONEY FOR THE BALANCE OF THE COST OF SAID RADIO; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town wishes to purchase a mobile radio for a Police take-home vehicle and to pay for the cost of said radio with grant proceeds from the Federal government and money from the Town's Law Enforcement Trust Funds (LETF), as described and outlined in the attached Agenda Item Report; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that the purchase of the mobile police radio is exempt from competitive bidding under Section 2-266(3) of the Town Purchasing Procedures; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police has recommended adoption of this Resolution and has determined that the proposed expenditure of LETF complies with F.S. 932.7055; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals Adopted. That each of the above stated recitals are hereby adopted and confirmed.

Section 2. Authorization of Purchase. The Council hereby authorizes and approves the purchase of the radio described in the attached Agenda Item Report.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Authorization of Expenditure.</u> The expenditure of Law Enforcement Trust Funds (LETF) in an amount not more than \$2,000.00 and the acceptance of grant proceeds of \$1,000.00 is hereby authorized and approved for the purchase of the radio.

**Section 4.** Implementation. That the Mayor and Town Manager are authorized to take any and all action which is necessary to implement this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
