RESOLUTION NO. 2289.13

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE TOWN CLERK'S CERTIFICATION OF THE RESULTS OF THE FEBRUARY 19, 2013 TOWN ELECTION FOR MAYOR AND TWO TOWN COUNCILMEMBERS, DESIGNATING THE VICE MAYOR; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to law and properly noticed, qualifying for a municipal election was held from December 31, 2012 to January 7, 2013 in the Town of Golden Beach; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to accept the unopposed re-election of Glenn Singer for a fifth term as Mayor; and

WHEREAS, for the Town Council desires to accept the unopposed re-election of Bernard Einstein for a fourth term and Judy Lusskin for a third term as Councilmembers; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to designate a Vice Mayor pursuant to the Town Charter.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Certification of the qualifying results of the February 19th, 2013 town election is accepted as follows:

Α. Mavor Glenn Singer Unopposed 2 year term

Town Council: Judy Lusskin Unopposed В. Unopposed Bernard Einstein 4 vear term

- That based upon the results, Glenn Singer is declared Section 2. Α. Mayor for a two-year term commencing immediately.
 - That based upon the results, Bernard Einstein is B. declared Town Councilmember for a four year term, commencing immediately.
 - C. That based upon the results, Judy Lusskin is declared Town Councilmember for a four year term. commencing immediately.

That Councilmember Judy Lusskin is hereby designated Vice Section 3. Mayor for one-year term commencing immediately, to be followed by Councilmember Bernard Einstein, Vice Mayor for the succeeding one-year term as decided by the Town Council.

That the provisions of this Resolution are Severability. Section 4. declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict Section 5. Conflict. with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective Section 6. immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
