A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN BEACH. **APPROVING** GOLDEN FLORIDA. AMENDMENT #2 TO THE 2014-2015 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET FOR THE PURPOSES OPERATING AWARDING EMPLOYEE BONUSES AND AMENDING THE ORIGINALLY ADOPTED BUDGET: PROVIDING FOR **PROVIDING IMPLEMENTATION:** AND **FOR** AN **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Recitals Adopted.</u> That each of the above-stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed.

Section 2. Amendment. The 2014-2015 fiscal year Operating Budget is hereby

amended as reflected on Exhibit "A" to this Resolution and the funds are appropriated for the purposes therein.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Implementation.</u> That the Mayor is authorized to take any and all action, which is necessary to implement this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
