A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, DECLARING CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY (POLICE K-9 DOG) OWNED BY THE TOWN TO HAVE NO INSTRINSIC MONETARY VALUE AND PROVIDING FOR DISPOSITION; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISPOSITION OF SUCH PERSONAL PROPERTY BY BILL OF SALE; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Golden Beach's (the Town's) police K-9 dog, "Jacob", is 5 years old and successfully completed the Police K-9 training on November 28th, 2012.

WHEREAS, the police K-9 dog "Jacob" as of April 26, 2016 was still not passing a new mandated FDLE gunfire training exercise and trainer Tony Guzman (Owner. & Trainer) at Metro Dade K-9 Services, where "Jacob" has been training since 2013, is not optimistic about "Jacob passing said training.

WHEREAS, due to Jacob's age, his inability to pass the FDLE mandated training exercise and because his assignment to another officer, based on his age, would be ineffective, the Town has determined that he has no intrinsic monetary value; and

WHEREAS, the Town wishes to decommission "Jacob," and as personal property of the Town, provide for his disposition and transfer to his handler, Officer Robin Weiner; and

WHERAS, the Town Council is authorized to determine that certain personal property owned by the Town has no value, is no longer needed for public purposes, and should be disposed of; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council hereby finds and determines that it is in the Town's best interest to decommission the police K-9 dog "Jacob" and provide for the disposition and transfer as personal property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Recitals Adopted.</u> Each of the above stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Determination.</u> The Town Council hereby finds and determines that the police K-9 dog "Jacob" should be decommissioned, has no intrinsic monetary value, and should be disposed of and transferred as personal property to his handler, Officer Robin Weiner.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Disposition Authorized.</u> The Town Manager is hereby authorized to dispose of and transfer the above referenced personal property by Bill of Sale, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A" once approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the Town Attorney, and any other procedures established by the Town Manager.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Implementation.</u> The Mayor and Town Manager are authorized to take any and all action which is necessary to implement this Resolution.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption hereof.
