## **RESOLUTION NO. 2249.12**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PARTICIPATION OF THE TOWN'S POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE PROCESS FOR OBTAINING ACCREDITATION BY THE COMMISSION FOR FLORIDA LAW ENFORCEMENT ACCREDITATION; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, under Florida State Statute 943.125, it is the intent of the Legislature that law enforcement agencies in the state be upgraded and strengthened through the adoption of meaningful standards of operation for those agencies; and

WHEREAS, under FSS 943.125, it is the further intent of the Legislature that law enforcement agencies voluntarily adopt standards designed to promote equal and fair law enforcement, to maximize the capability of law enforcement agencies to prevent and control criminal activities, and to increase interagency cooperation throughout the state; and

WHEREAS, the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation (CFA), an independent entity, whose Board of Directors is composed entirely of selected representatives from the Florida League of Cities, Florida Association of Counties, the Florida Judiciary, the Florida Sheriffs Association, and the Florida Police Chiefs Association, oversees the law enforcement agency accreditation program and officially accredits agencies that have passed the rigorous review process; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that the Golden Beach Police Department obtaining and maintain accreditation by the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation is in the best interest of the Town;
