

**TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2251.12**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE MAXIMUM PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE FOR F/Y 2012-2013; DIRECTING TOWN MAYOR AND TOWN MANAGER TO TRANSMIT PROPOSED MILLAGE TO PROPERTY APPRAISER OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PURSUANT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF FLORIDA STATUTES AND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on July 1, 2012, The Property Appraiser of Miami-Dade County, Florida, will serve upon the Town of Golden Beach (the "Town") a "Certification of Taxable Value" certifying to the Town its 2012 taxable value; and

**WHEREAS**, the provisions of Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, require that within thirty-five (35) days of service of the Certification of Taxable Value upon a municipality, said municipality shall be required to furnish to the Property Appraiser of Miami-Dade County the proposed millage rate, the current year rolled-back rate, and the date, time, and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage and the tentative budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town through its Mayor and Manager will comply with the submittal requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, based upon preliminary valuations provided by the Property Appraiser, the Town Council intends for the Town, through the Mayor and Manager, to advise the Property Appraiser that the proposed millage shall be an amount not to exceed 7.6556 mills and 1.5070 of voted millage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1. Recitals Adopted.** That each of the above stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed.

**Section 2. Direction to Town Mayor and Manager.** That the Town Mayor and Manager shall set the Proposed Millage and the Proposed Voted Millage at a rate not to exceed 7.6556 mills and 1.5070 voted mills respectively, and shall advise the Property Appraiser of said rates and provide the Property Appraiser with all other information required by law.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
