# TOWN GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA RESOLUTION NO. 1896.08

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO ALLOCATE UP TO A TOTAL OF FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$50,000) FROM THE TOWN HALL/PAVILION RENOVATION BUDGET, FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE FURNITURE AND OTHER ITEMS LISTED ON EXHIBIT "A" TO THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach, Florida authorized the renovation of the Beach Pavilion (Resolution No. 1871.07); and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that purchasing the items listed on Exhibit "A" including the lounge chairs, beach dinning-chairs, picnic tables, trash receptacles, minor-landscaping and other furnishings is in the best interest of the Town.

NOW, THREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 Recitals Adopted. That each of the above-stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed.

<u>Section 2</u> <u>Authorization.</u> That the Town Council hereby approves the expenditure of up to \$50,000 for the purchase of the items listed on Exhibit "A", subject to the purchasing provisions of the Town Code of Ordinances.

<u>Section 3</u> <u>Implementation.</u> That the Mayor and Town Manager are authorized to take any and all action which is necessary to implement this Resolution.

Section 4 Effective Date. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.

- 8 Trash receptacles with Town Seal (\$3,200 approximately)
- 2 Digital Clocks (\$150 approximately)
- 2 Digital Temperature Display Readers (\$150 approximately)
- North Walkway Enhanced Landscaping (\$12,000 approximately)
   Sea grapes, Palms and Vegetation
- Re-grading and Landscaping Around the Lifeguard Station (\$3,000 approximately)
- Re-Opening of the Pavilion Gift (ie. Beach Tote-Bag, Water Bottle and Beach Towel one per house) (\$10,000 approximately)
- Re-Opening / Ribbon Cutting Ceremonies for approximately 275 guest (\$7,500 approximately)
