## TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA RESOLUTION NO. 1984.09

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA AWARDING BID TO METRO EQUIPMENT SERVICES, INC. FOR THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on June 24th, 2008, the Town Council pursuant to Resolution No. 1929.08 selected a group of seven pre-qualified firms to submit bids to serve as the general contractor for the Town's Capital Improvement Program Project; and

WHEREAS, the pre-qualified firms have submitted bids pursuant to the Project Manual for the Capital Improvement Program, Ocean Boulevard Improvements (median landscaping, median lighting, and median irrigation), FDOT Side-Walk Installation (west side of A-1-A) and North and South Bound Median Entry Features (installation) (the "Bid Package"); and

WHEREAS, the Town has evaluated each of the submittals in accordance with the prescribed criteria; and

WHEREAS, the evaluation has resulted in a recommendation that the bid be awarded to Metro Equipment Services, Inc. as set forth in the Memorandum attached to this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has carefully considered and reviewed the evaluations and recommendation.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Recitals</u>. Each of the above stated recitals are hereby adopted, confirmed and incorporated herein.

Services, Inc. subject to the final execution of a contract substantially in the form and content contained within the Bid Package and subject to the prior approval of the Town Attorney.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Implementation</u>. The Town Mayor and Town Manager are hereby authorized to take all steps necessary to implement this Resolution.

<u>Section 4</u>. <u>Effective Date</u>. The resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
