A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE PAYMENT OF \$750.00 TO FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY BISCAYNE BAY CAMPUS IN MEMORIAM OF RICHARD FISHBEIN; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Richard and Alene Fishbein are long standing residents of the Town of Golden Beach; and

WHEREAS, the Fishbein family have been active and strong supporters of Florida International University Biscayne Bay Campus, which is the premier provider of public higher education in northern Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that a contribution in the amount of \$750.00 to the Florida International University Biscayne Bay Campus in memoriam of Richard Fishbein is in the best interest of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:
