RESOLUTION NO. 2026.09

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THREE CHANGE ORDERS TO THE CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION BETWEEN THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH AND SOUTHEASTERN ENGINEERING CONTRACTORS, INC.; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE;

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2008, the Town of Golden Beach (the "Town") passed Resolution No. 1950.08 awarding a Contract for Construction (the "Contract") in the amount of \$13,927,065.65 to Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc. ("Southeastern") for the construction of the Town's Capital Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the Town and Southeastern wish to amend the Contract to include certain work (the "Work") as described in the three change orders attached as Exhibit "A" to this Resolution (the "Change Orders"); and

WHEREAS, Southeastern has agreed to perform the Work; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Town of Golden Beach to approved the changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals Adopted. Each of the above stated recitals are hereby adopted, confirmed and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Approval and Authorization. The Town Council hereby approves the Change Orders contained in Exhibit "A," authorizes the expenditure of funds as

detailed in the Change Orders, and authorizes the Mayor to execute the Change Orders, on behalf of the Town, once approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the Town Attorney.

Section 3. Implementation. The Town Mayor and Town Manager are hereby authorized to take any and all action necessary to implement this Resolution in accordance with its terms and conditions.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.


In regard to SEC's request of \$1,352.30 for additional compensation to field modify structures #79 and #80, CAS is in agreement that the cost is consistent with current industry standards and should be approved.

In regard to SEC's two (2) letters dated February 25, 2009 requesting five (5) and six (6) days respectively, CAS is allowing these days to be held in abeyance until they are needed possibly at the end of the original contract time. If needed it will be the burden of SEC to substantiate the loss of time when and if it is necessary to use the additional days as part of the contract time.
