A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) NEW PICK-UP TRUCK FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach, Florida (the "Town") wishes to acquire one (1) new Pick-up Truck vehicle for the Public Works Department to replace an existing 2001 Pick-up Truck to use (the "Vehicle") as described and outlined in the attached Agenda Item Report; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Town's purchasing procedures, the Vehicle shall be obtained from or through the Florida Sheriffs' Association, Florida Association of Counties, and the Florida Fire Chiefs Association 2009-2010 Bid Award process from advertised bid lists or the procedures adopted by competitive bidding; or at the same or lower bid price and in compliance with the Town's purchasing procedures; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council finds that the purchase of this Vehicle is in the best interest of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Recitals Adopted.</u> That each of the above-stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed.

Section 2. Authorization of Purchase. The expenditure of funds in an amount not more than \$15,734.00 for the purchase and equipping of one (1) new Public Works Department pick-up truck, as described and outlined in the Agenda Item Report attached

and incorporated herein, is hereby authorized and approved. The Town Manager is authorized to purchase and equip this, or comparable vehicle, at a lesser price if he is able to do so in compliance with the Town's purchasing requirements.

**Section 3.** Implementation. That the Mayor and Town Manager are authorized to take any and all action, which is necessary to implement this Resolution.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

### Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Town Council adopt the attached Resolution No. 2112.10 as presented.

#### Background:

The Town wishes to purchase one (1) new (2010/2011) Pick-up Truck vehicle for the Public Works Department to use in the performance of Town duties.

The Public Works Department currently has three (3) 2001 Ford F-150 2-wheel drive Pick-ups that are in deplorable condition and are in need of replacement. It is our intention to replace each of these trucks over the course of the next three years. The new 2-wheel drive pick-up truck vehicle will replace one of the nine-year-old 2001 Ford two-door pick-up trucks currently in service in order to insure the continued cost efficient operation of the Town's vehicle fleet. That vehicle is in particularly poor operating condition.

The Florida State Sheriffs and Florida Association of Counties Annual Vehicle Bid Award will be utilized to insure the Town obtains the best price possible for the vehicle and to comply with the Town's purchasing requirements for items of this amount.

#### Fiscal Impact:

**Public Works Department Vehicle** - The cost for one (1) pick-up truck Public Works Department vehicle for \$15,734.00. The funds for these purchases will be taken from the Public Works Department's 2009/2010 Budget Accounts.

Cost for Obtaining Public Works Vehicle for 2010

As you have been advised, Vehicle 141, a 2001 Ford F-150 2-door Pick-up truck is in very poor condition and has become highly cost inefficient to maintain tin he Public Works Department fleet. Public Work Director Riley Crews and I are recommending it be replaced. There are sufficient funds remaining in the Public Works Department's 2009/2001 budget to replace the vehicle.

The cost to purchase and equip a ½-ton pick-up truck for the Public Works Department was identified from the Florida Sheriffs Bid process as \$13,989.00, options will be additional. Mr. Glen Carpenter of Maroone Ford advised the Town last year that when the Florida Sheriffs Association (FSA), Florida Association of Counties (FAC), and Florida Fire Chiefs Association (FFCA) sought vehicle bids in the summer of 2008, a 3.0 V-6 engine was standard in the Ford F-150 Pick-up. After the bids were submitted, Ford Motor Company discontinued the V-6 engine and made the 4.6 Liter V-8 engine standard, raising the price by \$1,825.00

A comparison with the Chevrolet Silverado ½-ton pick-up shows the same type vehicle with a comparable 4.8 Liter V-8 engine is \$15,821.00

Based on that information, it is recommended the Town purchase the vehicle from a dealer participating in the Florida Sheriffs and Florida Counties bid process.
