## **RESOLUTION NO. 2167.11**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; RATIFYING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF RAFAEL SUAREZ-RIVAS, ESQ. AS SPECIAL MAGISTRATE; AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN WITH MR. SUAREZ-RIVAS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-198 of the Town's Code of Ordinances, the Mayor has re-appointed Mr. Rafael Suarez-Rivas, Esq. to serve as a Special Magistrate to the Town; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Suarez-Rivas's outstanding reputation for civic pride, integrity, responsibility, professional ability, and interest in code enforcement qualifies him to serve as a Special Magistrate; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that ratification of the Mayor's appointment of Mr. Suarez-Rivas pursuant to Section 2-198(a) of the Town's Code of Ordinances is in the best interest of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals Adopted. That the foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Ratifying Appointment. That the Mayor's re-appointment of Rafael Suarez-Rivas, Esq. as a Special Magistrate is hereby ratified. Mr. Suarez-Rivas' term shall begin on the effective date of this resolution and end in one year.

Section 3. Authorizing Agreement. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, on behalf of the Town, with Mr. Suarez-Rivas setting forth the terms and fees associated with Mr. Suarez-Rivas' appointment and service as Special Magistrate, once approved by the Town Attorney as to form and legal sufficiency; provided the fee for serving as Special Magistrate shall not exceed \$125.00 per hour.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Implementation.</u> That the Mayor and Town Manager are authorized to take any and all action which is necessary to implement this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
