A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN'S ADMINISTRATION TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A GRANT FOR ASSISTANCE FOR 2011 UNDER THE FLORIDA INLAND NAVIGATION DISTRICT WATERWAYS ASSISTANCE **PROGRAM** FOR THE COST CONSTRUCTION OF A POLICE BOAT DOCK ON THE **PROVIDING** WATERWAY; INTRACOASTAL IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The Town of Golden Beach is interested in carrying out the following described project for the enjoyment of the citizenry of the Town of Golden Beach and the State of Florida:

Project Title	The Strand Park Boat Dock	
Total Estimated Cost \$	\$78,664.00	

Brief Description of Project: The project will result in the creation of a 49' long "T" shaped walkway, boat dock, and lift extending due west of the Town property located at the center of the west side of Center Island at The Strand. A boatlift will be attached on the west side of the 6' by 30' dock. The 43' dock walkway will provide Town residents and boaters with a scenic, view, a fishing opportunity, and an opportunity to temporarily moor sailboats, kayaks, canoes, and other non-motorized boats. The dock and boatlift will enable the Town's Marine Patrol Boat to provide more immediate police marine patrol service to the Intracoastal Waterway, AND

WHEREAS, Florida Inland Navigation District financial assistance is required for the program mentioned above,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals Adopted. That each of the above-stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed.

Section 2. Application That the Town of Golden Beach make application to the Florida Inland Navigation District in the amount of 37.8 % of the actual cost of the project in behalf of said Town of Golden Beach

Section 3. Acceptance That the Town will accept the terms and conditions set forth in FIND Rule 66B-2 F.A.C. and which will be a part of the Project Agreement for any assistance awarded under the attached proposal.

Section 4. Accordance That the Town is in complete accord with the attached proposal and that it will carry out the Program in the manner described in the proposal and any plans and specifications attached thereto unless prior approval for any change has been received from the District.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Financial Ability</u> That the Town has the ability and intention to finance its share of the cost of the project and that the project will be operated and maintained at the expense of the Town of Golden Beach for public and police use.

Section 6. Non-discrimination That the Town will not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, color or national origin in the use of any property or facility acquired or developed pursuant to this

proposal, and shall comply with the terms and intent of the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, P. L. 88-352 (1964) and design and construct all facilities to comply fully with statutes relating to accessibility by handicapped persons as well as other federal, state and local laws, rules and requirements.

<u>Section 7.</u> <u>Records</u> That Town will maintain adequate financial records on the proposed project to substantiate claims for reimbursement.

Section 8. Audit That the Town will make available to FIND if requested, a post-audit of expenses incurred on the project prior to, or in conjunction with, request for the final 10% of the funding agreed to by FIND.

Section 9. Authorization of Expenditure. The acceptance of the FIND Grants Funds and the expenditure of those FIND Grants Funds in an amount not more than \$29,735.00 for the construction and implementation of the Strand Park Boat Dock and Lift, as described and outlined in the Agenda Item Report attached and incorporated herein, is hereby authorized and approved.

<u>Section 10.</u> <u>Implementation.</u> That the Mayor and Town Manager are authorized to take any and all action which is necessary to implement this Resolution.

<u>Section 11.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
