RESOLUTION NO. 2184.11

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE USE OF LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND (LETF) MONIES TO RETAIN THE SERVICES OF OCEAN CONSULTING, LLC TO SECURE U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEER, STATE OF FLORIDA, MIAMIDADE COUNTY, AND GOLDEN BEACH PERMITS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A POLICE BOAT DOCK AND LIFT ON THE INTRA-COASTAL WATERWAY; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town desires to construct a police boat dock and lift on Center Island on the Intra-Coastal Waterway (ICW) for the residents of Golden Beach; and

WHEREAS, the cost retain the services of Ocean Consulting, LLC which specializes in obtaining these required construction permits is projected to be \$2,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Town's LETF account includes assets forfeited to the Town by authority of the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act and by the Federal Asset Forfeiture Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to utilize LETF funds to pay for this marine service to obtain the permits; and

WHEREAS, the monies contained in the LETF are the result of seized assets from both investigations by the Town's Police Department and joint investigations with other law enforcement agencies – not from tax revenue; and

WHEREAS, the Interim Chief of Police has recommended that the \$2,000.00 cost be taken from the Town's LETF for "other law enforcement purposes" specifically authorized by law; and

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WHEREAS, the Interim Chief of Police certifies that this expenditure complies with § 932.7055, Florida Statutes, and / or the Federal Seizure statutes in that the funds will be used for an appropriate law enforcement purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Interim Chief of Police certifies that the Town's LETF is not being used as a normal source of revenue for the Town Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Interim Chief of Police certifies that the Town's LETF was not considered in the adoption and approval of the Police Department budget; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that it is in the best interest of the Town to proceed as indicated in this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Recitals Adopted.</u> That each of the above-stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Use of LETF Authorized.</u> That the use of LETF funds to obtain the Marine Service to obtain these necessary permits is hereby authorized and approved.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Implementation.</u> That the Mayor and Town Manager are authorized to take any and all action which is necessary to implement this Resolution.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
