RESOLUTION NO. 2197.11

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AMENDMENT #2 TO THE 2010-2011 FISCAL YEAR OPERATING BUDGET; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach, Florida (the "Town") adopted an Operating Budget for the 2010-2011 Fiscal Year; and

WHEREAS, the Town Manager has recommended certain amendments as described in the September 14, 2011 Memorandum attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Golden Beach experienced higher than expected revenues in certain budgeted line items; and

WHEREAS, this amendment eliminates the need for the Town to use \$550,000 from the General Fund Balance (Reserves) to balance the fiscal year 2010-2011 operating budget; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that the proposed amendments are in the best interest of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals Adopted.

That each of the above-stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed.

Section 2. Amendment.

The 2010-2011 fiscal year Operating Budget is hereby amended as reflected on Exhibit "A" to this Resolution and the funds are appropriated for the purposes therein.

Section 3. Implementation.

That the Mayor is authorized to take any and all action, which is necessary to implement this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date.


This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.


