NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. That the name of the Councilperson who has proposed or sponsored a particular resolution or ordinance shall have his or her name affixed to that resolution or ordinance.
- <u>Section 2.</u> That more than one sponsor may be included in a resolution or ordinance, and no sponsor is required for legislation.
- <u>Section 3.</u> The presence or absence of a sponsor shall not affect the legality of resolutions or ordinances of the Town.
- Section 4. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.
- <u>Section 5. Conflict.</u> That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 6.</u> Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective seven calendar days following approval of the Town Council.
