## **RESOLUTION NO. 1169.99**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; ADOPTING THE AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE POLICE OFFICERS BARGAINING UNIT OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH; PROVIDING FOR A WAGE ADJUSTMENT, AMONG OTHER PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR FUNDING; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the representatives of the Town and the Dade County Police Benevolent Association, Inc. (on behalf of the police bargaining unit) have negotiated a proposed labor agreement; and

WHEREAS, the proposed agreement on May 4, 1999 was ratified by the police bargaining unit, passing by a majority vote; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council, after consideration of the issues, desires to adopt the agreement;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the three-year labor agreement between the Town of Golden Beach and the Dade County Police Benevolent Association on behalf of the police bargaining unit is hereby ratified; said agreement being effective immediately with some specified provisions effective retroactively to October 1, 1998. The agreement expires September 30, 2001. Retroactive benefits, if applicable, shall only be paid to employees in the bargaining unit that are employed by the Town on the effective date of this Resolution.

Section 2. The appropriate town officials are authorized and directed to execute the agreement.

<u>Section 3.</u> That funding for this agreement shall be appropriated from the police department budget.

Section 4. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

<u>Section 5.</u> Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 6.</u> Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
