## **RESOLUTION NO. 1174.99**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH BELLSOUTH, AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF PAYPHONES ON PUBLIC PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN; PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF PLACEMENT OF ANY AND ALL PAYPHONES WITHIN THE TOWN; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to enter into an agreement with BellSouth for the installation of payphones on public property within the Town;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the agreement with BellSouth for the installation of payphones on public property, in exchange for a portion of the toll charges generated, is hereby approved substantially in the form as attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A.

**Section 2.** That the Town Council shall approve the location of all payphones on public property within the Town by resolution of the Town Council. Currently, there is one payphone at the Town beach and one payphone at Tweddle Park.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the appropriate Town officials are hereby authorized and directed to execute the agreement.

Section 4. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 5. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
