

TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH
RESOLUTION NO. 1209.99

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR SALE/DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS PROPERTY PURSUANT TO TOWN CODE SECTION 2-308 OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 2-308 of the Town Code provides for the Sale/Disposal of surplus property; and

WHEREAS, in conformity therewith, the Town Mayor has determined that the property listed on the attached Exhibit "A" and is surplus property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. That the Town Council concurs in the recommendation of the Town Manager that the property listed on the attached Exhibit "A" and "B" is surplus property.

Section 2. That the Town Manager is hereby authorized to dispose of the surplus property listed on the attached Exhibit "A" and "B" in conformity with the provisions of Section 2-308 of the Town Code.

Section 3. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

Section 4. Severability. Should any provisions of this Resolution be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the Resolution as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.

Section 5. Effective date. That this Resolution shall become effective upon approval of the Town Council.

The Motion to adopt the foregoing Resolution was offered by Mayor Addicott, seconded by, Councilman Feinman and on roll call the following vote ensued:


