## RESOLUTION NO. 1241.00

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING THE APPROPRIATION AND EXPENDITURE OF \$1,995.00 FROM POLICE DEPARTMENT **FORFEITURE** ACCOUNT AS GOVERNED BY THE FLORIDA CONTRABAND AND FORFEITURE ACT AS MATCHING FUNDS FOR A \$1,000.00 GRANT AWARDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR THE PURCHASE OF A SPEED INFORMATION SIGN MODEL NO. MPH III: AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the Town of Golden Beach periodically will target areas where excessive speeds are reported; and,

WHEREAS, the current equipment used by the Town of Golden Beach Police Department has been in use for at least twelve (12) years and is no longer serviceable.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Town Council hereby approves the expenditure of \$1,955.00 from POLICE FINES and Forfeiture funds to purchase a Speed Information Sign, Model No. MPH III. The Town also accepts a grant awarded to the Town in February, 2000 in the amount of \$1,000.00 from the Department of Community Affairs Local Law Enforcement Block Program, for a total project cost of \$2,995.00 to fund the purchase of the requested Speed Information Sign.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Mayor, Police Chief and any other officials of the Town are authorized and directed to execute the necessary documents to accept this grant and make this purchase.

Section 3. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 4. Effective Date.</u> That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
