A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH. FLORIDA **APPROVING** THE APPROPRIATION AND EXPENDITURE OF \$2,832.00 FROM POLICE DEPARTMENT **FORFEITURE** ACCOUNT AS GOVERNED THE FLORIDA CONTRABAND BY AND FORFEITURE ACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF THREE (3) DELL **SERIES** BUSINESS COMPUTERS DIMENSION L MONITORS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE TOWN OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS: AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the Town of Golden Beach desires computers with increased higher memory capabilities to improve the efficiency of their computers; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of these computers will allow department to cycle one of our higher memory units to the guardhouse where there is no word processing capability at this time.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Town Council hereby approves the expenditure of \$2,832.00 from Police Fines and Forfeiture funds to purchase three (3) Dell Dimension L Series Business Computers and Monitors.

Section 2. That the Mayor, Police Chief and any other officials of the Town are authorized and directed to execute the necessary documents to make this purchase.

<u>Section 3.</u> Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

<u>Section 4. Conflict</u>. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 5.</u> Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
