## **RESOLUTION NO. 1243.00**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH. FLORIDA APPROVING APPROPRIATION AND EXPENDITURE OF \$5837.12 UNDER STATE OF FLORIDA BID NO. 070-840-99-1 FROM POLICE DEPARTMENT FORFEITURE ACCOUNT AS GOVERNED BY THE FLORIDA CONTRABAND AND FORFEITURE ACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) KAWASAKI ATV PRAIRIE 4 X 4 MODEL YEAR 2000 FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE TOWN OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY: PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS: AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the Town of Golden Beach will utilize the all terrain vehicle for concentrated beach patrol; and

WHEREAS, during the turtle nesting season, the Town's Ford Explorers should be utilized only during emergencies on the ocean-side because of the deep impressions that the weight and tires track on the sand.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Town Council hereby approves the expenditure of \$5837.12 under State of Florida Bid No. 070-840-99-1 from Police Fines and Forfeiture funds to purchase one (1) Kawasaki ATV Prairie 4 x 4 Model Year 2000.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Mayor, Police Chief and any other officials of the Town are authorized and directed to execute the necessary documents to make this purchase.

<u>Section 3.</u> Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 4. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 5. Effective Date.</u> That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
