**RESOLUTION NO. 1265.00**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN  
OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE SALE  
OF SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY PURSUANT TO  
ARTICLE VIII, PERSONAL PROPERTY, OF THE CODE  
OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH,  
FLORIDA

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN  
OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following described property is  
declared surplus and Town Clerk is hereby authorized to dispose  
of same as provided consistent with state law and the code of  
ordinances of the Town of Golden Beach:

One (1) 1992 Ford Pickup F-150 Long Bed (approx. mileage: 71,  
440)

One (1) 1992 Ford Pickup F-150 Long Bed (approx. mileage: 58,886)

one (1) 1994 Ford Pickup F-150 Long Bed (approx. mileage: 92,187)

Section 2. Severability. That the provisions of this  
Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section,  
sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any  
reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision  
shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses,  
sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in  
effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 3. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of  
resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed  
to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
