RESOLUTION NO. 1274.00

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$38,245.00 FOR PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT FOR THE TWEDDLE PARK PLAYGROUND; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town to expend public funds for playground equipment for the playground at Tweddle Park; and,

WHEREAS, the Town has reviewed bids submitted to other governmental agencies pursuant to competitive bidding procedures;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Town Council hereby authorizes the expenditure of the sum of \$38,245.00 for playground equipment for the playground at Tweddle Park.

Section 2. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 3. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of

resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.


The Motion to adopt the foregoing resolution was offered by Mayor Addicott, seconded by Councilman Paruas and on roll call the following vote ensued:
