GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA RESOLUTION NO. 1275.00

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH FLORIDA, APPROVING A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF AVENTURA, FLORIDA, FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES; INCLUDING MARINE PATROL PROVISIONS, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE TOWN OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the continuing possibility exists that public safety concerns could cause the Chiefs of Police of City of Aventura or Golden Beach to seek additional resources for law enforcement purposes on a short-term basis.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mutual Aid Agreement between the Town of Golden Beach and City of Aventura for the period of January 1, 2001 through January 1, 2006, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the Mutual Aid Agreement will include and permit concurrent marine patrol related jurisdiction between agencies on the waters, waterways, canals, channels, rivers, lakes streams, and any and all other bodies of waters, including the Intercoastal Waterway and that fall within either jurisdiction at this or any future time during the term of this Mutual Aid agreement.

Section 3. The Mayor and other Town officials are authorized and directed to execute this agreement.

Section 4. Severability. Should any provisions of this Resolution be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the Resolution as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.

<u>Section 5.</u> Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 6.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> That this Resolution shall become effective upon approval of the Town Council.
