

**GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA
RESOLUTION NO. 1276.00**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; ACCEPTING A GRANT AWARD FROM THE DADE COUNTY DRUG CONTROL AND SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001 AND SUPPORTING THE COMMUNITY DRUG & CRIME PREVENTION PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE TOWN OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACTS IN SUPPORT OF THE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Golden Beach wishes to accept the grant award from the Dade County Drug Control and System Improvement Program for fiscal year 2001 and supports the Community Drug & Crime Prevention Project; and

WHEREAS, the Town is prepared to match the federal funds provided with a 25% Cash Match OF \$128.00; and

WHEREAS, Sec.4.01(a)(2) of the Town Charter authorizes the Mayor to execute all contracts or other obligations on behalf of the Town as approved by the Council;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Town of Golden Beach accepts the federal funds in the amount of \$383.00 and agrees to provide a 25% Cash Match in the amount of \$128.00, making the total amount of the project budget not to exceed \$511.00.

Section 2. That the appropriate Town officials are authorized to execute the necessary documents for this grant award.

Section 3. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity

of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.


Section 4. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.

The Motion to adopt the foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilwoman Chikovsky, seconded by Councilman Paruas and on roll call the following vote ensued:


