A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA ACCEPTING THE LOW BID FOR DESIGN AND BUILD FOR THE POLICE GUARDHOUSE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to enter into an agreement for design and build for the police guardhouse;

<u>Section 1. Authorization for Agreement.</u> That the Town Council hereby accepts the low bid of \$118,700.00 for design and build for the police guardhouse.

Section 2. Form of Contract The attached proposal will be incorporated into a contract in a form and content prepared by and acceptable to the Town Attorney.

Section 3 Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

<u>Section 4 Conflict.</u> That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 5. Effective Date.</u> That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
