## RESOLUTION NO. 1329.01

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING COUNCILMEMBER STANLEY J. FEINMAN TO TEST THE QUALITY OF THE STORMWATER DISCHARGE FROM GOLDEN BEACH INTO THE INTERCOASTAL AND APPROVING AN EXPENDITURE OF UP TO \$1,000.00 FOR TESTINGBY AN INDEPENDENT LABORATORY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Councilmember Stanley J. Feinman is hereby authorized to test the quality of the stormwater discharge from Golden Beach into the intercoastal. Furthermore, an expenditure of up to \$1,000.00 for testing by an independent laboratory be, and it is hereby approved.

Section 2. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 3. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
