A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA DEDICATING THE PROPOSED MANATEE VIEWING PLATFORM TO TOWN RESIDENT AND ARDENT ENVIRONMENTALIST HAROLD KRONSTADT AND AUTHORIZING THE TOWN ADMINISTRATION TO PLACE APPROPRIATELY WORDED PLAQUE AT THE SITE UPON COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Harold Kronstadt has been an ardent environmentalist; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to recognize the many contributions to the public of Harold Kronstadt; and

WHEREAS, the Town is in the process of constructing a manatee viewing platform; and

WHEREAS, it has been deemed appropriate to name the manatee viewing platform in honor of Harold Kronstadt.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the manatee viewing platform to be constructed by the Town shall be named in honor of Harold Kronstadt.

Section 2. The Town Administration be, and it is hereby directed to place an appropriately worded plaque at the site upon completion of the project.

Section 3. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.
