RESOLUTION NO. 1352.01

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND INTERIM TOWN MANAGER TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY FOR ASSUMPTION OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR MAINTENANCE OF SIGNS FOR STREET NAMES, PARKING RESTRICTIONS AND SPEED LIMITS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Interim Town Manager be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to sign an Agreement with Miami-Dade County for assumption of responsibility for maintenance of signs for street names, parking restrictions and speed limits, in a form similar to that attached as Exhibit "A".

Section 2. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 3. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
