RESOLUTION NO. 1355.01

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE MILLAGE RATE FOR TAXATION OF REAL PROPERTY LYING WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001/2002 COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2001 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2002; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the Town of Golden Beach, Florida is a municipality located in Miami-Dade County, Florida; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the Town of Golden Beach, Florida's proposed millage rate for fiscal year 2001/2002 was held at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 5, 2001 at the Town of Golden Beach, One Golden Beach Drive, Golden Beach, Florida;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The final millage rate approved and adopted for the taxation of all real property lying within the boundaries of the Town of Golden Beach, Florida shall be \$8.59 per \$1,000 of assessed property value for the fiscal year 2001/2002.

Section 2. The percentage by which this millage rate to be levied exceeds the rolled-back rate of 6.927 mills (computed pursuant to Florida law) is 24.0075%. This is the percentage increase in property taxes adopted by the Town of Golden Beach.

Section 3. This final millage rate of \$8.59 per \$1,000 of taxable value is for the calendar year 2001 to fund the expenses for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2001 and ending September 30, 2002.

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Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to forward certified copies of this Resolution to the Miami-Dade County Property Appraiser, the Miami-Dade County Revenue Collector, and the Florida Department of Revenue.

Section 5. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 6. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


Section 7. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.

The Motion to adopt the foregoing resolution was offered by Councilmember Paruas seconded by Councilmember Einstein and on roll call the following vote ensued:


