A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING THE POSITION OF A FULL TIME BUILDING OFFICIAL FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE 2001/2002 FISCAL YEAR AND INTRADEPARTMENTAL TRANSFER OF \$10,000.00 FROM LINE ITEM 524-1810-01 TO LINE ITEM 524-1100-01 AND \$15,000.00 FROM LINE ITEM 524-3100-01 to LINE ITEM 524-1100-01 TO PROVIDE A SALARY OF \$60,000.00 to \$65,000.00 FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE FISCAL YEAR BASED ON \$65,000.00 ANNUAL SALARY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Golden Beach desires to create the position of full time building official;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the position of a full time building official is hereby approved for the remainder of the 2002/2002 fiscal year and an intradepartmental transfer of \$10,000.00 from line item 524-1810-01 to line item 524-1100-01 and \$15,000.00 from line item 524-3100-01 to line item 524-1100-01 to provide a salary of \$60,000.00 to 65,000.00 for the remainder of the fiscal year based on \$65,000.00 annual salary. Said position is subject to the negotiations and approval of the Mayor and Town Attorney.

Section 2. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 3. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 4. Effective Date.</u> That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
