A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; GRANTING A VARIANCE REQUEST FOR PROPERTY LOCATED AT 540 NORTH ISLAND DRIVE, GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, GB SECTION "F", LOTS 10 & 11, BLOCK M, AS RECORDED IN PB 10-11 OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY; REQUESTING RELIEF FROM TOWN CODE SECTION 66-186(d), WHICH PROVIDES THAT NO WALLS, HEDGES, OR FENCES HIGHER THAN FOUR FEET MAY BE ERECTED ON THE STREET PROPERTY LINE, NOR ERECTED IN SUCH MANNER, PLANTED AND PERMITTED TO GROW SO AS TO BLOCK THE VIEW OF DRIVER OF A VEHICLE OR BICYCLE OPERATING ON ANY ROAD WITH THE TOWN AS PROVIDED BY SECTION 66-120; REQUEST IS TO ALLOW COLUMNS TO BE 6 FEET HIGH AND GATE TO BE AT 7 FEET; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, George and Caren Brod have applied for the following variance:

A variance requesting relief from Town Code Section 66-186(d), which provides that no walls, hedges, or fences higher than four feet may be erected on the street property line, nor erected in such manner, planted and permitted to grow so as to block the view of driver of a vehicle or bicycle operating on any road with the Town as provided by Section 66-120; request is to allow columns to be 6 feet high and gate to be at 7 feet.

WHEREAS, a public hearing of the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach was advertised and held, as required by law, and all interested parties were given an opportunity to be heard, and

WHEREAS, upon due and proper consideration having being given to the matter, it is the opinion of this Town Council that the requested variance is not contrary to the public interest and that

special conditions do exist whereby a literal enforcement of the provisions of the Town's Code of Ordinances will result in unnecessary and undue hardship on the applicant.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the requested variance is hereby approved as follows: relief from Town Code Section 66-186(d) to allow columns to be 6 feet high and gate to be at 7 feet.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the application as approved, is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) A Building Permit for the contemplated work pursuant to the Variance must be obtained within two (2) years from the date of this Resolution. If no Building Permit is issued within the two (2) year time limit, then the Variance approval will be null and void.
- (b) The applicant shall record a certified copy of this Resolution in the public records of Miami-Dade County.

Section 3. The Building and Zoning Director is hereby directed to make the necessary notations upon the maps and records of the Town of Golden Beach Building and Zoning Department and to issue all permits in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Resolution. A copy of this Resolution shall be attached to the building permit application documents.

<u>Section 4.</u> Conflict. That all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Severability. Should any provisions of this Resolution be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the Resolution as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.

Section 6. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
