NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the Mayor and Town Council hereby support the Town of Surfside's request for a state audit of the construction program of Miami-Dade County Public Schools.

Section 2. Severability.
