RESOLUTION NO. 1407.02

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER, WITH MAYOR'S CONSENT, TO ALLOCATE CAR ALLOWANCES AND CELL PHONES AMONG EMPLOYEES AND DEPARTMENT HEADS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the budget adopted by the Town of Golden Beach provides for car allowances and cell phone service for certain employees and department heads; and

WHEREAS, Section 5.01 of the Charter of the Town of Golden Beach provides that the Town Manager shall be responsible for the administration of the government, subject to the advice and consent of the Mayor;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Town Manager, with the advice and consent of the Mayor, shall allocate, at his discretion, among the employees and department heads, all budgeted car allowances and cell phones.

Section 2. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 3. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
