**RESOLUTION NO. 1417.02**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA TERMINATING THE APPOINTMENT OF ROSEMARY WASCURA AS TOWN CLERK; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.04(d) of the Charter provides that the Council shall appoint a Town Clerk who shall serve at the will of the Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town that Rosemary Wascura should not continue to serve in the position of Town Clerk;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** That the appointment of Rosemary Wascura as Town Clerk be, and it is hereby terminated.

**Section 2. Severability.** That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

**Section 3. Conflict.** That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.




The Motion to adopt the foregoing resolution was offered by Mayor Addicott, seconded by Vice Mayor Einstein and on roll call the following vote ensued:
