RESOLUTION NO. 1422.02

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE BUDGET OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2002, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2003, PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTES SECTION 200.065 (TRIM BILL); PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Manager presented to the Mayor and Town Council a proposed budget for fiscal year commencing October 1, 2002, for approval by the Town Council; and

WHEREAS, the Town has properly noticed the second public hearing scheduled for September 17, 2002, at 6:15 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall located at One Golden Beach Drive, Golden Beach, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the said second public hearing will be held as noticed and the public and all interested parties having had an opportunity to address their comments to the Town Council and having complied with the "TRIM" requirements of the Florida Statutes;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the tentative budget as presented by Town Manager to the Mayor and Town Council for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2002, and ending September 30, 2003, be and is hereby adopted.

<u>Section 2.</u> The second public hearing of the 2002-2003 Town of Golden Beach budget will be noticed as required by law in a newspaper of general circulation and has been announced at this first public hearing.

Section 3. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be

invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

<u>Section 4. Conflict.</u> That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
