**RESOLUTION NO. 1442.03**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND TOWN MANAGER TO PAY HOLIDAY BONUSES TO EMPLOYEES, INCLUDING POLICE OFFICERS, IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,000.00; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The Town Council hereby adopts a policy whereby annual bonuses will be paid to all municipal employees, including police officers. The bonuses shall be distributed by the Mayor and Town Manager at their discretion and shall not exceed \$5,000.00 in any fiscal year.

**Section 2. Severability.** That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

**Section 3. Conflict.** That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.


