RESOLUTION NO. 1456.03

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA EXPRESSING OPPOSITION TO SENATE BILL 1164 AND HOUSE BILL 113 WHICH SET FORTH AMENDMENTS TO THE BERT J. HARRIS, JR. ACT AND ANY AND ALL OTHER PROPOSED AMENDMENTS THAT WOULD SUBJECT LOCAL AND STATE GOVERNMENTS TO FURTHER LIABILITY FOR THE CONSTITUTIONAL EXERCISE OF THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES AND POWERS; TRANSMITTING THE RESOLUTION TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE, SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE AND GOVERNOR; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach hereby expresses opposition to Senate Bill 1164 and House Bill 113 which set forth amendments to the Bert J. Harris, Jr. Act and any and all other proposed amendments that would subject local and state governments to further liability for the constitutional exercise of their responsibilities and powers. A copy of the Resolution shall be transmitted to the President of the Senate, Speaker of the House and Governor.

Section 2. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 3. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


Section 4. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.


