**RESOLUTION NO. 1473.03**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO TRANSFER A TOTAL OF EIGHTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$85,000.00) FROM THE GENERAL GOVERNMENT/CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT NO. 519-500930 TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT/RENTALS AND LEASES ACCOUNT NO. 521-500440 IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$35,000.00) FOR FIVE POLICE VEHICLES AND THE REMAINING FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$50,000.00) INTO PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT/LANDSCAPING & MAINTENANCE ACCOUNT NO. 539-500467 FOR LANDSCAPING IMPROVEMENTS TO THE A-1-A MEDIAN AND GATEHOUSE AREAS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach adopted a General Fund Budget for the Fiscal Year 2002-2003; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council has adopted a resolution authorizing the purchase of police vehicles and previously approved the expenditure of funds for landscaping improvements to the A-1-A median and gatehouse areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Manager has recommended that an interdepartmental transfer be made from the General Government/Contingency Account to the Law Enforcement/Rentals and Leases Account to purchase police vehicles and to the Public Works Department/Landscaping & Maintenance Account for landscaping improvements to A-1-A median and gatehouse areas;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** That the Town Manager is hereby authorized to transfer Thirty Five Thousand Dollars from Account No. 519-500930 General Government/Contingency Account into Account No. 521-500440 Law Enforcement/Rentals & Leases and the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars from Account No. 519-500930 General Government/Contingency Account into Account No. 539-500467 Public Works Department/Landscaping & Maintenance.

**Section 2. Severability.** That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

**Section 3. Conflict.** That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


**Section 4. Effective Date.** That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.


The Motion to adopt the foregoing resolution was offered by Councilmember Singer, seconded by Vice Mayor Iglesias and on roll call the following vote ensued:
