RESOLUTION NO. 1483.03

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE MAYOR AND TOWN ADMINISTRATION TO ENTER INTO AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH AND ACOSTA NURSERY, INC. FOR SUPPLEMENTAL LANDSCAPING SERVICES WITH A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$52,062.00; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN ATTORNEY TO PREPARE AN AMENDMENT TO THE CURRENT CONTRACT WITH ACOSTA LANDSCAPING FOR THE SUPPLEMENTAL LANDSCAPING WORK; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Town Council hereby authorizes an amendment be drafted to the Agreement between the Town of Golden Beach and Acosta Nursery, Inc. to replace a portion of the plants in the A-1-A median, add sod, potting soil, mulch, and trim palms in accordance with the proposal attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein as if set forth in full, in an amount not to exceed \$52,062.00.

Section 2. The Town Attorney is directed to draft an amendment incorporating Exhibit "A" referenced above. Said amendment shall include language determined appropriate by both the Town Attorney and the Mayor and may be executed by the Mayor, without further action of the Town Council and Town Administration.

Section 3. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

<u>Section 4. Conflict.</u> That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.

Removal of Angelonia (or Mexican Sage) in #14 beds of the A1A median. Replacement plants as noted below. Re-arrange Bromeliads from mass plantings into a snake-like design with mulch δ sod.

Trim 122 paims as needed - #21 Date palms, #24 Coconut palms and #77 Sabal palms.

Prepare beds for new plantings/sod by removing 3-4" old mulch & soil and replacing with potting or top soil & new mulch applied around the paims.
